

Important Reminders for Student Safe Arrival Procedures

As we begin a new school year, we would like to remind families to report any student absences, especially during the first few weeks of school. We recognize some families may be on extended vacations, transfer schools, or move out of Board and ask that you contact the school to inform office staff if you have not done so already.

As per Board Policy 228A, if your child's absence is still not verified even after exhausting different steps to connect with the family, York Regional Police will be contacted and may be dispatched to your residence.

We remind parent(s)/guardian(s) to update the school with all emergency contact information when changes are made. Thank you for your cooperation in reporting student absences.

Emergency Forms

We kindly request all families complete and update the school emergency forms by the end of next week. This will help to ensure we have the most up-to-date information.



Pick Up Routines

If there is a change in the pick-up of your child at the end of the school day, please ensure that a note is provided to the classroom teacher and the main office.

Also, if your child is leaving early, please ensure that it is entered into the Safe Arrival system.



Medical Forms

If your child/children have medical needs such as an anaphylactic allergy, asthma or require the use of prescription or non-prescription medication, please visit our school website to download and complete any required forms.

Bus Information

Please check the <u>School Bus City Website</u> for your child's route and pick-up/dropoff time and location. It also will post late bus information. It is encouraged that in the morning, students arrive 10 minutes before their scheduled time during the first two weeks of school.
