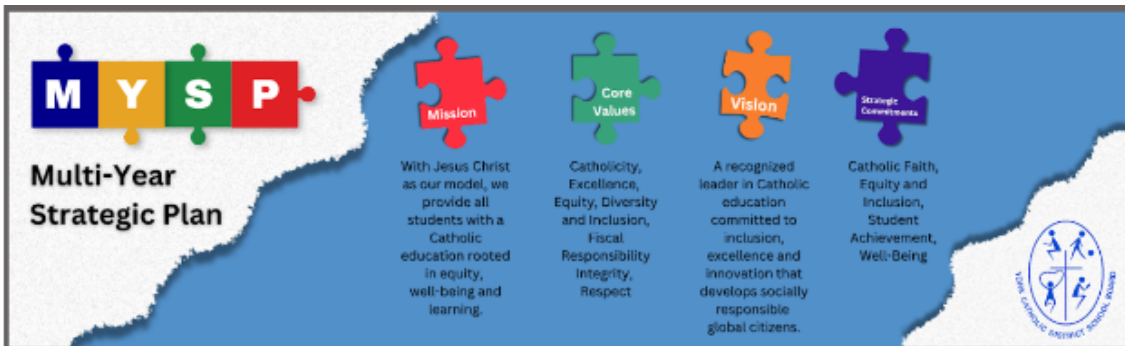

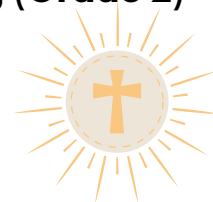

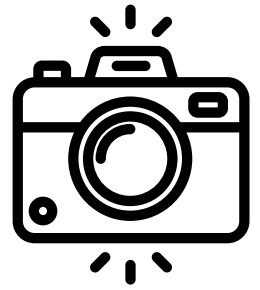

Did you know that vision problems can affect learning, reading, and classroom participation? Children often don't realize they have vision issues. That's why a comprehensive eye exam is recommended before school starts.

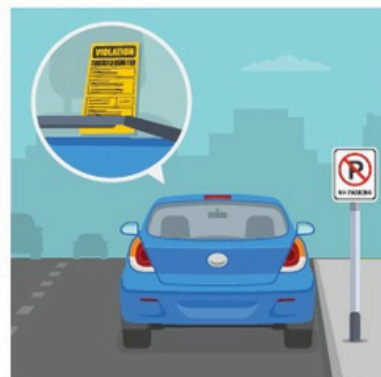
