

BRAVE WORKSHOPS COMING TO SPP

On Friday, October 17th, we look forward to the anti-bullying workshops presented by BRAVE Education to all of our students from K to 8. The workshops will be tailored to the age group and topic.

<u>Setting Healthy Boundaries: Grades K to 3</u>

Students in Grades K to 3 will participate in the 'Setting Healthy Boundaries Workshop'. In this workshop, children will be introduced to the children's book, How Brave Found His Roar. Students will practice their body language and tone of voice through role-playing BRAVE's Walk Away, Talk Away, and Block Away communication steps.

Bullying, Conflicts, and Relationships: Grades 4 to 8

During this workshop, students will learn why conflict happens, how it is essential to friendships, and how to distinguish the difference between conflict and bullying. Students explore how, even in the healthiest of relationships, there can be uncomfortable interactions.

ACTIVE SCHOOL TRAVEL SAFETY CAMPAIGN KEEPING OUR SCHOOL ZONE SAFE

We all play an important role in helping to create safe school zones and supporting student safety and well-being.

If you choose to drive, when dropping off and picking up your child, remember:

- If using the designated kiss and ride, follow all markings in the loop.
- Do not exit your vehicle in the loop and follow all posted signage.
- Have your child enter/ exit vehicle from the passenger side.
- Consider parking away from the school and walking your child to school, or if they are old enough allow them to walk the last couple of blocks alone.
- Obey the crossing guard and posted parking signs and road markings.
- Stop for school buses and be aware of children running in front of or behind buses.
- Reduce your speed.
- Be alert and ready to stop at all times.
- Ensure you make a full stop at all stop signs.
- Wait for students to complete their crossing before proceeding.









If you are walking, when dropping off and picking up your child remember to:

- · Walk on available sidewalks.
- Always cross at an intersection or crosswalk.
- Obey crossing guards.
- Stop before stepping onto the road.
- Be visible and indicate your intention to cross.
- Look and listen for traffic in all directions.
- When one is available, push the cross button. Wait until you see the pedestrian walk signal.
- Keep an eye out for turning vehicles and cars reversing on driveways.
- Walk do not run, do not cycle and do not skateboard across the road.
- Cross only when the road is clear.
- Pay attention to your surroundings, do not use devices while crossing the road.


