

# WINTER CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES

- A friendly reminder that students are encouraged to wear layered clothing during the winter weather.
- This includes hats, gloves, scarves, snow pants, and winter boots.
- We are encouraging all students to wear winter boots and snow pants, especially if they would like to play on the field or in the snow.
- Our Intermediate Grades must have boots and are encouraged to wear snow pants if they would like to be on the field.
- It is always a good practice to ensure students have extra clothing.
- Thank you for your continued support.

#### **COLD WEATHER ACTION PLAN**

The cold weather is upon us. Please ensure that students bring their winter hats, snow pants, boots, gloves, scarves, and winter jackets to dress appropriately and safely for the weather.

Our school, in cooperation with our Catholic School Council, has set the extreme cold weather temperature (including wind chill) at -17 degrees Celsius.

When this temperature is reached the following strategies may be implemented:

- Operate an indoor routine or a shortened outdoor routine of up to 20 minutes.
- Students are monitored for signs of frostbite, frostnip, or difficulty breathing.
- Students are reminded to stay dry, dress in layers of warm clothing with an outer layer that is wind-resistant, wear proper head coverings, gloves, and winter boots.

Staff will also share valuable insights from EQAO research into assessment results, which can help parents and guardians support their children's math learning.


